Please make cheques payable to the school you will be attending in the 2011-2012 school year. The payment schedule is described below. Full payment can be made at time of application.

ALL FEES - Including fees from previous years must be paid in full and cheques must be cleared before your child will be registered in any Alberni District Hockey Canada Skills Academy classes.

Once the course has started, refunds will only be given to students who move out of the school district. A refund of 50% will be given should a student leave during the first half of the program and no refund will be available for students who leave during the second half of the program.

Students who are injured during the season will not receive refunds unless they completely withdraw from the program subject to the above refund policy

Selection Criteria

Eligibility

This program is open to any female or male student in grades 6 to 12 registered in School District #70.

School Credit

Students in Grade 9 – 12 will receive their grade equivalent PE credit.

Class Times:

Grade 6/7 – ice time is 1:30pm – 2:30pm

Students will be bussed to the multiplex but parents must arrange transportation from the rink following the ice session.

Grade 8 – ice time is 8:30am – 9:30am

Students will be bussed back to school but parents must arrange a drop off at the rink in the morning.

Class Length:

All sessions are 1 hour in length

Grade 6/7 – 1 term running September to 1st week of December

Grade 8 – 2 terms running September to March

Grade 9 – All year running September to the end of June on alternate days

Grade 10-12 Mixed and Female – First semester running September to end of January

Transportation

AM classes – students must be dropped off at the multiplex by parents and students will be bussed back to their home school.

Mid Morning Class (ADSS only) – students will be bussed to and from the multiplex

PM classes – students will be bussed to the multiplex but must be picked up by parents

Equipment

It is possible for students to store their gear at the school however parents are encouraged to drop off and pick up gear at the multiplex.

It is very helpful if parents can pick up their child's hockey equipment as soon as possible following each session. With over 100 students in the academy, the lobby area at the Multiplex becomes very congested. Your assistance is very much appreciated.

Code of Conduct

Being enrolled into the Hockey Canada Skills Academy is a privilege. Not all applicants are accepted into the program. This program is intended to improve your motivation and focus in all subject areas. We expect your best efforts in all aspects of the hockey program: fitness training, classroom assignments, dry land training and on-ice activities.

The 3 Rs of our Academy

1. **Respect**
 - Your teacher
 - Your teammates, and their personal property.
 - Your guest instructors
 - The facilities that you use.
 - The learning environment.

2. **Responsibility**
 - For your attendance. Let your teacher know when you will be absent.
 - For being on time.
 - For bringing your gear each day. Full gear is required for all on-ice sessions.
 - For your actions and language.
 - For informing your teacher of your health.
 - For your dressing room at the Multiplex.
 - For your attitude – keep it positive.

3. **Results**
 - Work to the best of your ability each day.
 - Take advantage of this opportunity to develop more than just your hockey skills – perseverance, determination, leadership, team building etc.

Students who are consistently misbehaving in the multiplex and in the changerooms will be removed from the Academy.

Students who are suspended from school for major infractions including fighting, illegal substance abuse and non-attendance may be removed from the Academy.

Students who are removed from the Academy for mis-behaviour or suspension will receive **No Refund**.
