We are anticipating the following **Class Times** however these are subject to change depending on ice availability. As well, some **Class Times** will be non-ice times and will involve fitness and off-ice activities.

### **Class Times:**

**Grade 6/7 – ice time is 1:30pm – 2:30pm**

**Students will be bussed to the multiplex but parents must arrange transportation from the rink following the ice session.**

**Grade 8 – ice time is 8:30am – 9:30am (Fridays 8:15am – 9:15am)**

**Students will be bussed back to school but parents must arrange a drop off at the rink in the morning.**

Class Length:

All sessions are 1 hour in length

Grade 6/7 – 1 term running September to 1<sup>st</sup> week of December

Grade 8 – 2 terms running September to March

Grade 9 – All year running September to the end of June

Grade 10-12 – 1 semester running September to end of January

### **Eligibility**

This program is open to any female or male student in grades 6 to 12 registered in School District #70.

### **School Credit**

Students in Grade 9 – 12 will receive their grade equivalent PE credit.

### **Transportation**

AM classes – students must be dropped off at the multiplex by parents and students will be bussed back to their home school.

Mid Morning Class (ADSS only) – students will be bussed to and from the multiplex

PM classes – students will be bussed to the multiplex but must be picked up by parents

### **Equipment**

It is possible for students to store their gear at the school however parents are encouraged to drop off and pick up gear at the multiplex.

### **Financial Aid**

### **Selection Criteria**

We have only a certain number of spaces in the Academy. Selection will be based on the first applications received with payment.

NSF cheques and non-payment will be considered an incomplete application and will move to the bottom of the wait list.

Students who have experienced behavioural issues in the previous school year may not be accepted.
